Exercise based on a Bio-terrorist attack

Exercise Background:

A major influential terrorist organization has placed an embedded person in a major lab in South East Asia with the intent of procuring and distributing an aerosolized weaponized biological agent with plans to release the weaponized agent inside major critical infrastructure venues in the City Center of Bangkok to include the mass transit system during an international sports gathering that will draw hundreds of thousands of spectators from around the world. This release will be during the rush hour of the event to try and contaminate as many victims as possible. It is unknown the virulence and nature of the agent at this time. Only by a letter sent to the government that this release has taken place was there any advanced notification that the agent is supposedly air borne. It is unknown at this time how many have been affected and how far this agent has reached in the community. Combining these metrics has the potential for a worldwide cataclysmic event with cascading effects that will impact the global economy and cause systematic shutdown beginning with the host country with an escalated potential of worldwide exposure.

Current Pre-Exercise Objectives:

1. an agency's current state of emergency preparedness
2. gaps, weaknesses, or areas of concern affecting the agency's performance as identified through prior exercises
3. level of staff knowledge and understanding of emergency preparedness roles and responsibilities
4. applicability to emerging problems

Expected Outcomes:

- Ability to identify multi-agency roles and responsibilities during a biological incident response;
- Development of a performance gap analysis at both the national and regional levels;
- Development of a training needs analysis.
- Development of best practices and training for response agencies in relative modalities to the AHJ.
